STUDENT-ATHLETE CAREER NIGHT

Annually, the OSAD brings 55+ employers to campus interested in recruiting student-athletes for jobs and internships across various industries. Employers meet with student-athletes, share job opportunities, and make invaluable connections through an informal mixer and traditional career fair.

CAREER CHAMPION SERIES

Career panels of industry professionals and alumni from a specific career field of interest are organized. Panelists share valuable insight of daily responsibilities on the job, personal experiences navigating career paths, and helpful advice for student-athletes interested in entering their profession.



BADGER EXPLORATION EXPERIENCE

On-the-job insight is valuable while exploring career fields, serve as a resource and engage with our student-athletes through informational interviews, connect with career mentors, or job shadow onsite.

CAREER STRATEGIES (1-CREDIT COURSE)

Offered each semester, this course is designed to engage employers with interactive curriculum through mock interviews and career panels. Visiting consultants also speak in class about finances, hiring trends and networking.



BADGER CONNECTIONS BBQ

Each summer, the OSAD hosts a BBQ to provide a venue for student-athletes, faculty, staff, coaches, Madison community members, alumni and employers to develop a valuable network.

BEYOND THE GAME (BTG)

Throughout the year, the OSAD organizes BTG programs including monthly "Real Talks" and bi-annual "Dinner Series" events. These are opportunities for employers and alumni to enhance post-graduate trajectories for student-athletes.

NCAA Compliance Guidelines for Employers - Communication with Student-Athletes: Protecting the eligibility of our University of Wisconsin student-athletes is of the utmost importance. Through your willingness to assist our student-athletes in their career exploration, you share in this responsibility by agreeing to not provide any benefits or privileges to student-athletes that are not provided to all similarly-situated individuals/employees. This includes transportation, meals, entertainment, etc. Additionally, student-athletes' names, images, or appearances may not be used to promote your organization or a commercial product. Finally, any employment of student-athletes requires you to compensate them only at the going rate, only for work actually performed, and not for any value they bring to your organization due to their athletic status.

CREATE YOUR PROFILE

- Go to uwbadgers.com/hireabadger
- Once account is created, go to **PROFILE** page & click on each tab to fill in necessary information

POST A JOB OR INTERNSHIP

- Click **JOBS** tab in left sidebar of your **HOME** page — click **JOB POSTINGS** — click red **POST A JOB** button
- Fill in **POSITION INFORMATION** — click **ADD ITEM** at bottom of page to submit description
- The OSAD will review and approve/decline submissions within 24 hours. Employer will receive email notification once approved, and the job will be posted for 30 days. If still vacant, please repost after 30 days have expired.

VIEW STUDENT-ATHLETE RESUMES

- Access to resume book user rights are given to employers by the OSAD when requested
- After receiving access, click **RESUME BOOKS** tab on left sidebar — **VIEW** resume books currently available
- To request a resume book of job applicants for a specific position, go to **JOBS** in left sidebar — choose the position — **STUDENT APPLICATIONS** — **BATCH OPTION** — **GENERATE BOOK**. Once resumes are processed, find the finished resume book via **JOBS** — **PUBLICATION REQUESTS**

SCHEDULE ON-CAMPUS RECRUITING

- To request a recruiting schedule, click on the **CREATE SCHEDULE REQUEST** link in the **SHORTCUTS** section from **HOME** page, OR go to the **OCR** tab — **SCHEDULES** — **REQUEST A SCHEDULE**
- All **OCR** data is stored here, so upload positions and select students for interviews by simply using the **OCR** tab

ATTEND EVENTS

- Information Sessions: to register, access "**REQUEST AN EMPLOYER INFORMATION SESSION**" shortcut link through home page or go to **EVENTS** — **INFORMATION SESSIONS** — **REQUEST INFORMATION SESSION**
- Career Fairs: to register, access **EVENTS** — **CAREER FAIRS** tab to see a list of fairs
